



CITY OF MONTEBELLO PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Montebello will hold a Public Hearing in the Council Chamber of the Montebello City Hall, 1600 West Beverly Boulevard, Montebello, California and via telephonically and/or electronically, on **Wednesday, July 28, 2021, at 6:30 p.m.**, or as soon as possible thereafter as the matter can be heard, to consider the following:

Receive public input regarding the naming of a City-owned facility:

The City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider a request to name a City-owned facility at Montebello City Park the "Bill Walters Memorial Cabin." On March 10, 2021, the City adopted specific policies for the naming of City-owned Land, Buildings, Parks and Community Facilities (Resolution No. 21-08). As required by Resolution No. 21-08 a public hearing is scheduled.

All interested persons have the right to appear and be heard pursuant to Governor Newsom's Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20. For those interested in making public comments, the City will receive your comments by contacting the City Clerk's office **on or before Wednesday July 28, 2021 between 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. at (323) 887-1359**. Staff will complete the speaker cards and the public will be called during the City Council meeting – Closed Session begins at 5:30 p.m. and Regular Session begins at 6:30 p.m. The exact call back time is not predictable due to the nature of the City Council agenda. As a result, you must be available until the end of the meeting to receive a live call from staff during the meeting. The City has created an email address ccpubliccomment@cityofmontebello.com where the public can submit public comments from **9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 28, 2021**. These questions will be read out loud and submitted for the record. If you challenge the subject matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council, at, or prior to, the public hearing.
